Coordinating Care Outside the Practice

Before scheduling an appointment with a specialist, please call our office. We are affiliated with Boston Children's Hospital and refer to them for specialist providers.

Our providers can provide many advanced primary care services in the office, such management of asthma, ADHD and acne and more. Your child's provider will work with you to determine if a visit to a specialist is needed.

***If your child does receive care at an outside facility, such as a specialist office or emergency room, please ask the outside facility to send the records to our office after your visit so we can be sure we have all the information needed to best serve your child. Some plans require an authorization from your insurance company to see this specialist, urgent care, etc. We will need the following information to process this:

- Specialist name
- National Provider Identifier Number (NPI)
- Date of service
- Phone number
- Fax number
- Reason for appointment
- Number of visits

Well Child Care and Immunizations

Preventive health care, including immunizations, is very important in keeping your child healthy. We follow all preventive health care recommendations of the American Academy of Pediatrics as described in the table below.

Our Well Visit Schedule
